

Privacy Policy

Beaver Paper a member of Koehler Paper Group ("Beaver Paper") is committed to promoting user confidence in the use of its website. This Privacy Policy ("Policy") outlines our policies and practices regarding the personal information we collect and use. This Policy applies to consumers in the U.S. and applies only to information collected about them through our website, https://www.beaverpaper.com/, with the exception of the section entitled "California Residents: Your Rights" which applies to personal information collected about California residents both online and offline. Consumers accessing our website from outside the United States should refer to our International Privacy Policy which can be found at https://www.beaverpaper.com/terms-and-conditions/.

Information Collection

Personal information we collect through our website includes, but is not limited to:

- First and last name;
- Email address:
- Company Name; and
- Telephone number.

Beaver Paper also collects other types of non-personal information about your visit to our website. For example, we may capture browser, device, or IP address information in order to monitor the number of people that visit our website and other aggregated statistics in order to improve our website. We also collect personal information you choose to submit through online inquiry forms or surveys.

Information Use

Beaver Paper uses personal and non-personal information for the following purposes:

- To communicate with consumers and businesses, including responding to inquiries received through the website;
- To send information about our products and services we believe will be of interest to a particular consumer or business;
- To improve and administer our website;
- To market and conduct market research; and
- To monitor for fraud.

Information Disclosure

Beaver Paper may disclose personal information we collect to third party service providers with whom we have a contractual relationship. These third parties are contractually obligated to keep the personal information confidential and not to use it for purposes other than the purposes for which it has been collected. Beaver Paper may also disclose personal information in the event of a merger, sale, or acquisition, or as required by law or law enforcement.

Beaver Paper does not sell personal information.

Cookies

Beaver Paper may utilize cookies to improve our website and your experience with it. Cookies are small files or other types of information storage that are transferred to the web browser of a user by our web server or a third party webserver and stored on your computer's hard drive for subsequent retrieval. We may utilize cookies to enable our website to tailor information to the visitor, to remember a visitor, and to track visits to our website. While most browsers are set to accept cookies by default, you can set yours to refuse cookies or alert you before accepting them. However, be aware that if you do not accept cookies from our website, you may not be able to use some of its features.

Beaver Paper may also use third party web analytics providers such as Google Analytics to help us analyze how visitors are using our website. You can opt-out of Google Analytics by downloading the Google Analytics Opt-Out Browser Add-on.

Do Not Track Signals

Right to Know About Personal Information Collected, Disclosed, or Sold

You have the right to request that Beaver Paper disclose certain information to you about our collection, use, disclosure and sale of your personal information over the past twelve (12) months. Once we receive and confirm your request, to the extent you have requested them, we will disclose to you:

- The categories of personal information we collected about you;
- The categories of sources from which the personal information was collected;
- Our business or commercial purpose for collecting that personal information;
- The categories of third parties with whom we shared that personal information, if any;
- The specific pieces of personal information we have collected about you (also called a data portability request); and/or
- If we sold or disclosed your personal information for a business purpose, two separate lists disclosing:
 - Disclosures for a business purpose, identifying the personal information categories that each category of recipient obtained; and
 - Sales, identifying the personal information categories that each category of recipient purchased. Beaver Paper does not sell personal information.

Right to Request Deletion of Personal Information

You have the right to request that Beaver Paper delete any of the personal information we have collected and maintain about you, subject to certain exceptions. Once we receive and confirm your request, we will either delete, de-identify, or aggregate your personal information, unless not doing so is permitted by the CCPA for reasons such as, but not limited to, the fact that the personal information is necessary for us or our service provider(s) to:

- Complete the transaction for which we collected the personal information, take actions
 reasonably anticipated within the context of our business relationship with you, or
 otherwise perform our contract with you.
- Comply with the California Electronic Communications Privacy Act (Cal. Penal Code § 1546 et. seq.).
- Enable solely internal uses that are reasonably aligned with consumer expectations based on your relationship with us.
- Comply with a legal obligation.

• Make other internal and lawful uses of that information that are compatible with the context in which you provided it.

Exercising Your Rights to Know and Deletion

Your request to know or delete must:

- Provide sufficient information that allows us to reasonably verify you are the person about whom we collected personal information or an authorized representative of that person; and
- Describe your request with sufficient detail that allows us to properly understand, evaluate, and respond to it.

In order to submit a consumer request, you must provide Beaver Paper with your name and email address. We will then remit any requested information to the mailing address or email address we have on file for you. If you would like to receive a response at a different mailing or email address than the ones we have on file for you, you will need to provide us two to three pieces of personal information, depending on the sensitivity of the information that is the subject of the request, to allow us to verify your identity. Only you, or someone legally authorized to act on your behalf (i.e., your authorized agent), may make a request related to your personal information. Beaver Paper may require an agent to provide verification that he or she is acting on your behalf. We cannot respond to your request if we cannot verify your identity or authority to make the request.

Non-Discrimination

Beaver Paper will not discriminate against you for exercising any of your CCPA rights. Unless permitted by the CCPA, we will not:

- Deny you services;
- Charge you different prices or rates for services, including through granting discounts or other benefits, or imposing penalties;
- Provide you a different level or quality of services; or
- Suggest that you may receive a different price or rate for services or a different level or quality of services.
